Annual Commitment Form

The ADX Investor Relations Guide establishes a common framework for how listed companies communicate with investors and the market. At its foundation are 6 minimum requirements (see below) that apply to every company listed on ADX, calibrated to its market category.

This Annual Commitment Form is how your company formally affirms its adherence to those requirements. It is completed once upon the framework's introduction (or upon listing), and renewed each year thereafter. Beyond confirming compliance, the annual cycle gives ADX an accurate, current record of your IR function and contact points and forms the basis on which companies are assessed for ADX's IR recognition and awards program.

This form is to be completed and signed by the company's Investor Relations Officer (IRO) and Chief Financial Officer (CFO) or their equivalents. Completed forms should be submitted to the ADX Corporate Relations team at CorporateRelations@adx.ae.

Minimum Requirements

ADX has established six minimum requirements for investor relations that apply to all listed companies. They cover the foundations of an IR function, including having a designated IR officer, maintaining an IR webpage, and keeping an investor presentation current, as well as disclosure standards and periodic and annual reporting obligations. Together, they are designed to ensure that every listed company, whether on the Main Market or the Growth Market, has the basic infrastructure in place to communicate effectively with investors and the broader market.

Failure to meet the minimum requirements may result in warnings and/or monetary penalties. Any applicable penalties will be specified in warning letters and applied to the annual listing renewal fees at the discretion of ADX management, subject to the severity and degree of non-compliance.
